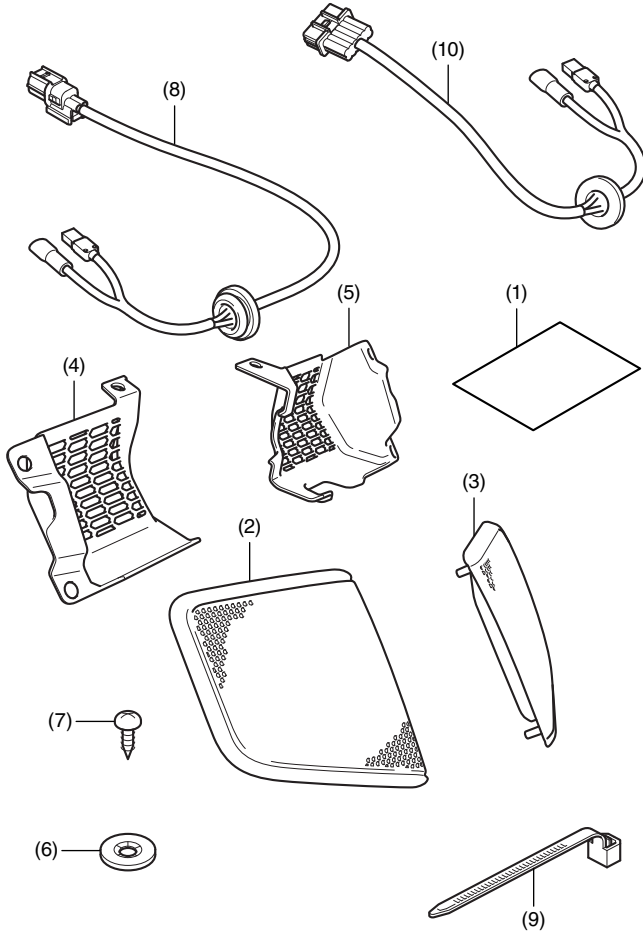

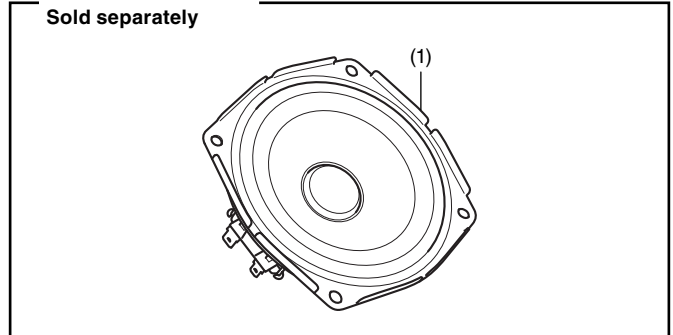

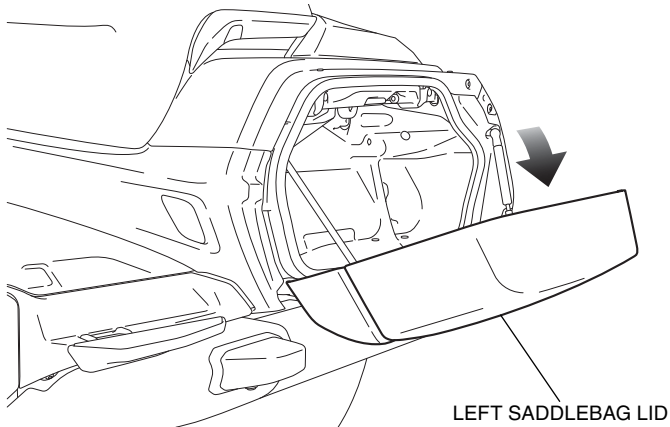
NOTE:

- Disconnect the negative (-) cable from the battery before installing this accessory.
- The memory of the clock will be erased when you disconnect the battery. Reset the clock after reconnecting the battery.
- Reinstall the removed parts on the motorcycle and make sure that the wires and harnesses are not pinched.
- Trim the excess ends off the wire ties after attaching them to the wire harnesses. Do not allow the cut part of the wire tie to interfere with another harness or brake hose.

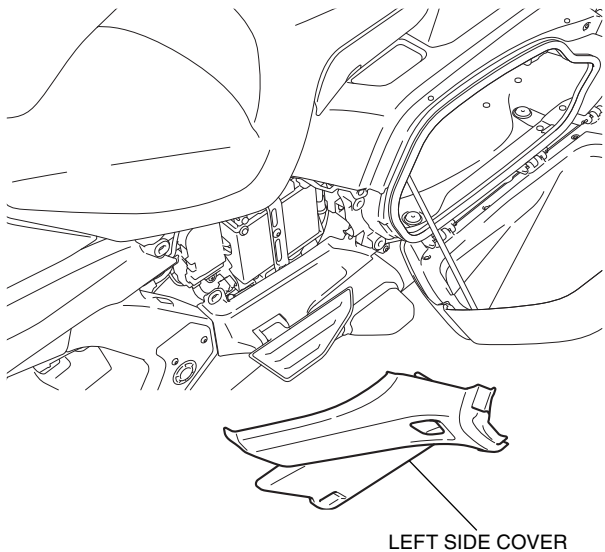

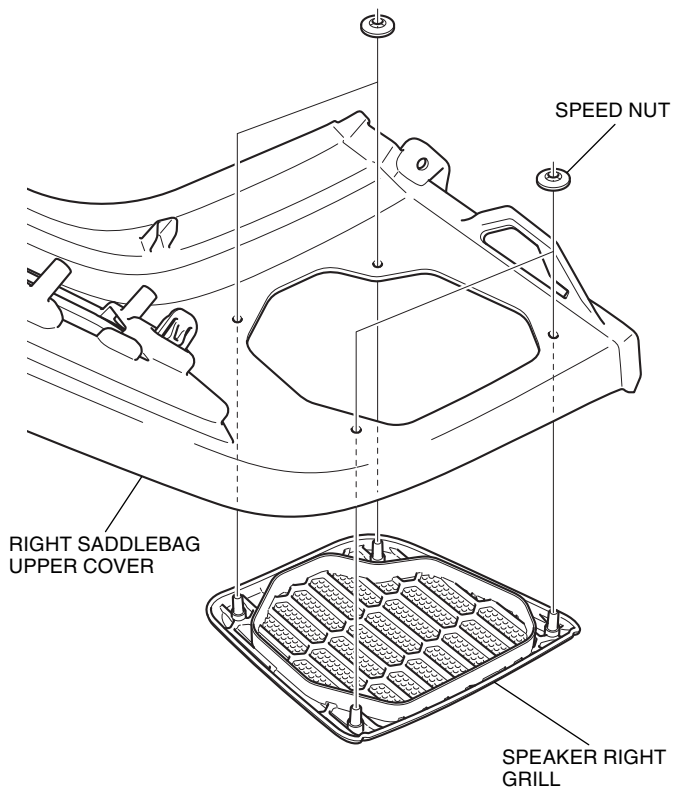

22. Install the right speaker grill as shown.

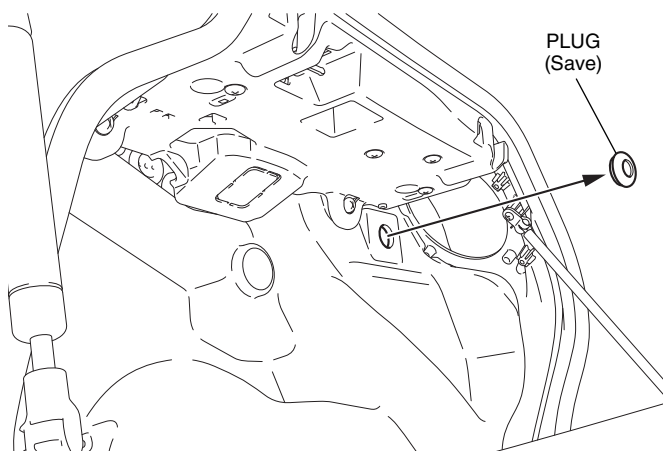

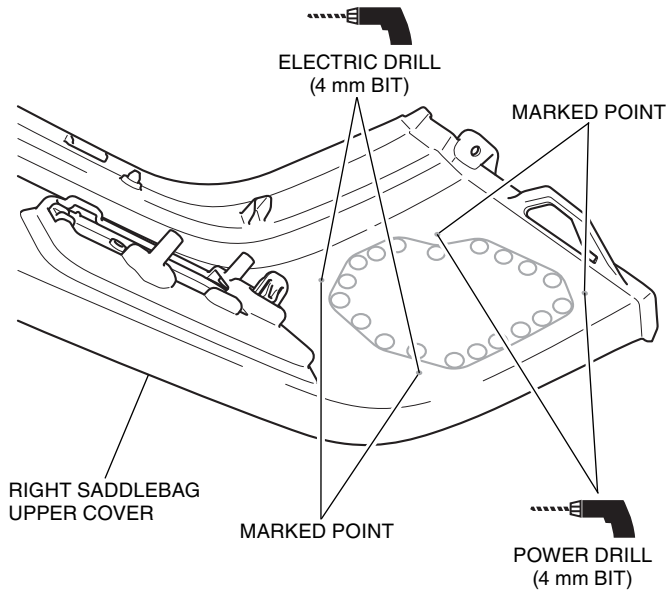
18. Arrange the accessory rear speaker as shown and confirm that there is no interference with the drilled hole.

- If there is interference, use a file to correct it.



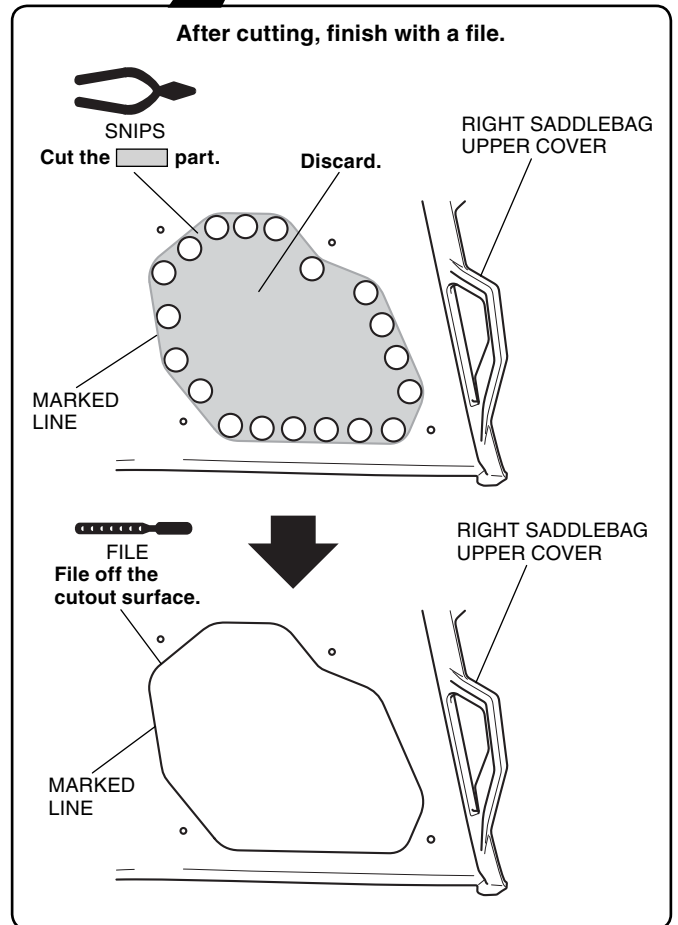
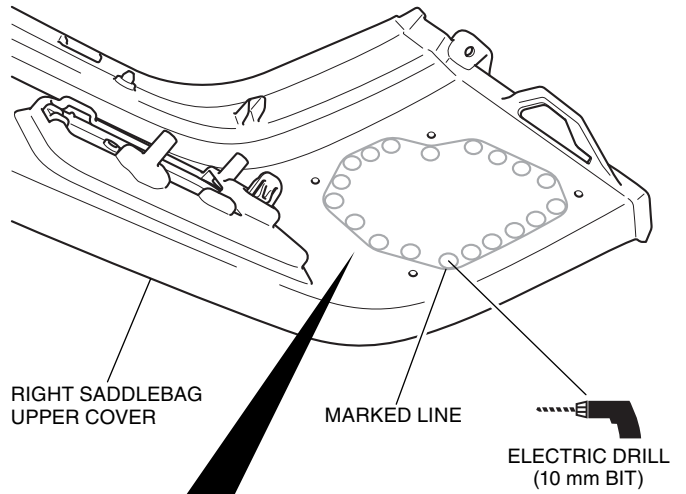
19. Drill a 4 mm hole at each marked point of the right saddlebag upper cover as shown.

20. Drill 10 mm holes at the marked lines of the right saddlebag upper cover as shown.

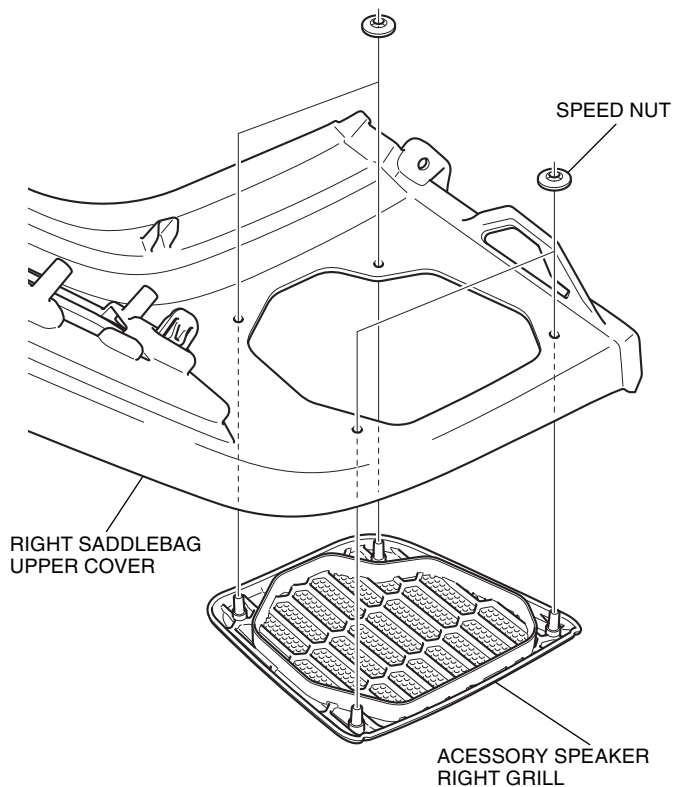
- Drill holes at the center of the marked lines.

23. Install the accessory speaker right grill as shown.

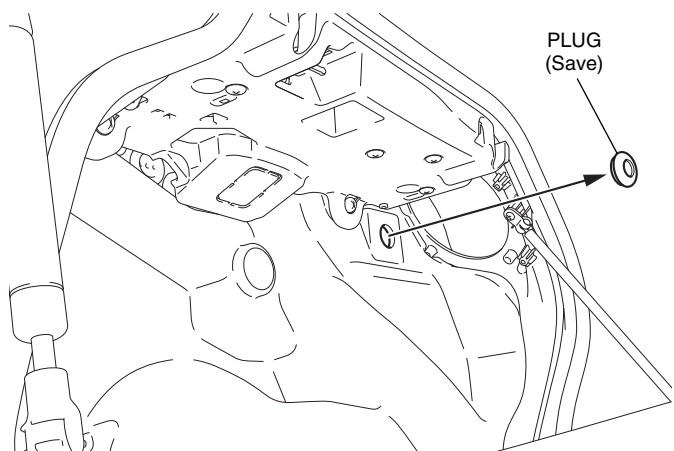
